

Dr. KARINA PAULINA MARCZUK is a former Deputy Director of the Office of the Head, National Security Bureau – Chancellery of the President of the Republic of Poland. Currently, she works as a guest-lecturer for the National Security Study, Warsaw University, Poland. She is also an Assistant Professor at the Customs & Logistic School, in Warsaw, Poland. In addition, since 2007, she has been a member of *The International Network to Promote the Rule of Law* (INPROL). She graduated at The Federal Institute of Technology (ETH), in Zurich, Switzerland (Strategic Analysis Course *StartA*) and National Defense University (NDU), School for National Security Executive Education, Center for Technology and National Security Policy, Washington D.C., The USA (*American-Polish Bioterrorism Defense Workshop*).

The area of interests of Dr. KARINA PAULINA MARCZUK concerns internal security issues and activity of constabulary forces (Carabinieri/Gendarmerie like Forces) in the Mediterranean countries. Specifically, she performs research on the complex security theory as well as on human security. She particularly focuses on the Balkan and Mediterranean affairs. Currently, she is working on the book devoted to the evolution of the security policy of Romania.
